Vancouver Templeton NC Lions - Archery Tag - Aug 7

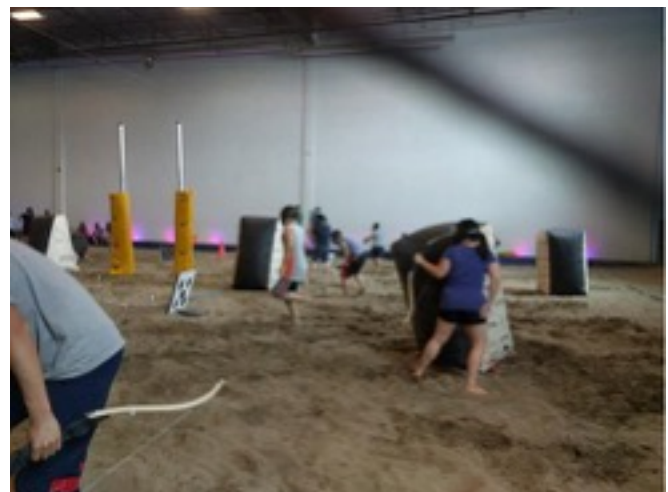
